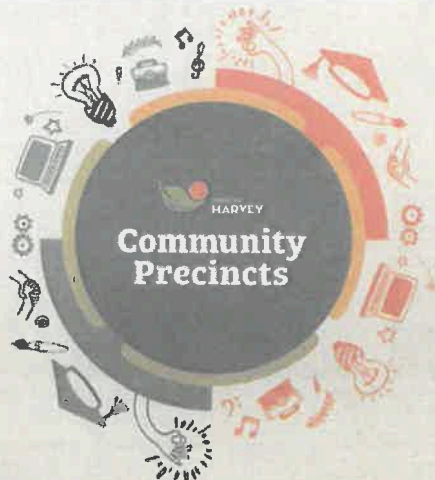

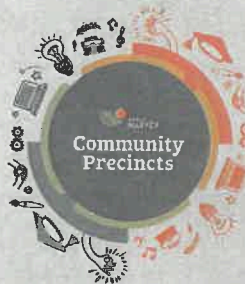

The local community will be involved at every stage, creating an open conversation to ensure all ideas, thoughts and opinions are heard.

For future development to continue, the Shire is seeking community feedback on the future community precincts in Australind and Harvey.

Harvey Community Precinct

The Harvey Community Precinct draft master plan is a visual representation of what could be achieved. It is a dynamic long term planning document that considers the connection between buildings, social settings and the surrounding environment and coordinates future investment.

Detailed design will assess all community feedback to ensure the precinct is designed to cater for the Shire's current and future needs, for our children and grandchildren to use.

75% of the proposed facilities are community facilities, with provision for a library, RSL, play group, community resource centre, community radio, arts, youth and indigenous yarning included.

An events room, accessible to the public for bookings, will be used as a Council Chamber when required.

The sports ground parking will be increased to include parking for both the sporting facilities and the community and Shire parking needs. There is provision for accessible parking.

The development of the community precincts will be staged. Design and documentation will commence by the end of this year. Construction of the first phase, which includes the new library, is planned to start in late 2022.

2021-2022 Budget Endorsed by Council

The Council adopted the \$75 million Shire of Harvey budget on Tuesday, 27 July. A key focus for the budget is to continue to build an even better lifestyle to meet the needs of our growing population and the many communities in our Shire.

In 2021-2022 some of the areas the Shire is investing into its community includes:

- \$9.7M to provide, expand and improve our community facilities.
- \$4.1M to manage parks, reserves and recreation grounds.
- \$0.4M to upgrade playgrounds.
- \$0.6M in community grants.
- \$0.9M dedicated to community safety including \$0.6M fire prevention and control.
- \$17.4M to maintain and expand road, drainage and footpath infrastructure.
- \$4.3M to manage our waste and recycling.
- \$6.7M to manage our recreational centres.

The reconstruction of the Yarloop Workshops and Men's Shed are highlights of the budget.

Planning will continue in 2021-2022 for both the Australind and Harvey Community Precincts, and the Leschenault Leisure Centre courts expansion.



The six-week public consultation period for the Shire of Harvey Community Precincts will end on Tuesday, 3 August 2021.
