6.2. Update on Major Projects over \$500k

- Leschenault Leisure Centre Court Expansion
 - Seeking funding commitments
- Brunswick Power and Lights Upgrade
 - Project completed with positive stakeholder feedback.

6.3. Update on all other projects

- Brunswick Tennis Courts
 - Construction drawings received. Waiting for minor amendments to lighting design. Tender to be developed for distribution December/January 2026.
- Harvey Golf Club Extension
 - o Tender process currently underway.
- Oval 1 lighting
 - Oval 1 included in over \$500k category. Grant application for Club Night Lights submitted in October 2024. Currently awaiting assessment. Timelines include below dates and actions:
 - o 2025/2026 CNLP Forward Planning round
 - June 2024

 Application forms available from local governments (metro area only) and department regional offices (regional WA only).

August 2024

 Applications to be lodged at local government by the end of August 2024. Applicants should check the closing date with their local government, as they do vary.

September 2024

- Applications are assessed by local government staff and recommendations prepared. Local governments are required to rate and rank all applications they receive in order of priority.
- Applications presented at local government council meeting.
- Applications must be lodged at DLGSC regional offices by 4pm on 30 September 2024.

October 2024

- Applications are assessed by DLGSC regional managers.
- Applications are assessed by state sporting associations.
- December 2024/January 2025
 - CSRFF Advisory Committee considers applications and makes recommendations to the Minister.
 - Hon Minister for Sport and Recreation considers recommendations and grants approvals.
 - Successful/unsuccessful applicants notified.
- 1 July 2025
 - Funds available.
- 15 June 2026
 - Grant must be acquitted (except forward planning grants that have approval to expend the funds in the second and third year of funding).
- Harvey Bulls Football Change rooms
 - Seeking funding commitment.
- Harvey Recreation Ground
 - Meeting with consultant early December to review assessment and proposal of options.
- Leschenault Recreation Ground
 - Oval 2 renovation is progressing

- Oval 1 as per grant application
- Oval 7 and 8 included in advocacy document for funding
- Oval 6 Cricket turf. Requires additional playing fields 7 and 8 to proceed as identified in the Recreation Plan.
- Pavilion building B23.39 \$175K and B24.31 \$250K in the Forward capital Works. Project is yet to have a project leader assigned.
- Binningup Bowling Club
 - o Accessibility Ramp to commence in January 2025.
- Leschenault Cricket Club
 - Tree removed near Oval 3 Turf practice wickets.

7. Access and Inclusion

Action 25: Pool hoist and pool accessibility.

Current pool hoist is beyond repair. Investigations to date have revealed:

- Pool hoists available do not lower low enough to be effective. Therefore, a pool hoist or the pool ledge needs to be modified.
- There is no equipotential bonding (electricity earthing) surrounding the pool. Respectively earthing all metal fittings would cost in excess of \$60k.

9. Other Business

- · Harvey Hockey Club:
 - o Two teams
 - Seeking to play indoor hockey in off season
 - Harvey Swimming Club (HSC):
 - Struggling to attract volunteers
 - o Provided BBQ for numerous events
 - Swimming WA to arrange a splash and dash meet. This event will encourage the community to have a go at swimming. Once date and time available HSC to inform group.
- Yarloop Equestrian Association:
 - o Active equine club
 - o Two rallies per month
 - o 74 members in June 2024, now 53 members
 - Currently six-monthly agreement with South-West Horse Trials Stanton.
 Current issues at Stanton Park include:
 - · Lack of water
 - Harvey Water and Shire in discussions.
 - Fire control
 - Fencing issues including upcoming South-Western Highway modifications

- Amenities
- Not set-up for multi-group equestrian centre (Stanton Park not favoured by YEA as a permanent equestrian facility)
- Harvey Rifle Range wanting to expand their area which reduces the equestrian area available at Stanton Park. Changes required due to legislation changes.
- Club owns \$30,000 worth of assets
- Seeking permanent purpose-built facility
- South-West Horse Trials (SWHT):
 - New committee in 2024
 - Harvey Water pipeline has caused erosion and access issues to areas of Park. Ongoing discussion
 - Last 4 years Shire has mown grass
 - Fundraised for numerous developments including fencing on Honeymoon Road.
 - No water source at Stanton Park. Currently trucking water into Park.
 \$8-\$10k required to fund water pipe to leased area.
 - Successfully applied for Alcoa Sustainability fund to purchase showjumping club

Action 26: Shire to investigate opportunities for equestrian clubs and activities including a presentation to Council.

- Kidsport Regional Pools Program (KRPP):
 - Original Kidsport program released by State Govt in response to costof living-crisis for Vacswim.
 - KRPP will be delivered by local governments with the support of the Department of Local Government Sport and Cultural Industries (DGLSC).
 - DLGSC inviting local governments to participate in the KidSport Regional Pools Program to offer free pool passes to increase physical activity and water safety awareness of eligible children aged 5-18 years in your community.
 - Will initially be offered as a trial.
 - Brunswick Show:
 - Successful show with 21,000 attendees
 - o Equestrian stakeholders would prefer Sunday as event date
 - Brunswick Bowling Club
 - Two-day carnival with 144 player attendance in December annually
 - A-green upgrades completed on Brunswick Show day
 - Regional championships held in January 2025
 - Appreciation for Shire maintenance staff
 - Thank you to Shire Property Maintenance Officer Dudley Greathead
 - Leschenault Cricket Club
 - o Tree removed on Oval 4
 - Increased club numbers
 - Matches added on Sundays

- Cricket teams wearing vibrant colours across the State to increase the appeal of cricket
- o Aim to break ground for new project in April 2025
- o Various upcoming events:
 - Australian country championships, Saturday 4th edition of Ahlias day (brain cancer)
 - Charity events including Ahlia's day and financial assistance for a club member
 - Club thanked Shire for state of turf wicket
